**Rusty Nail** - Cutty Sark Scotch and Drambuie. \$6.50

The Rusty Nail is strictly an American invention that became fashionable in the 1950s with people who wanted their scotch without the bite of a Rob Roy. The name seems to indicate fierceness, but the honeyed characteristic of Drambuie imparts a mellow tone. It is said that the Rusty Nail was named by one of several Scottish bartenders who repaid the incivility of loud American customers by stirring this drink with a rusty nail. One look at this ruddy amber cocktail would indicate the actual source of its name.

## Today's Selections

Euro: Liter 9.50, .5 L 4.95, .3L 3.95 or as marked

**Bitburger Pilsner** (Germany): Very pale & extremely light. Clean, soft maltiness & a firm hop finish. Germany's first Pilsner, since 1883.

**Bayern Dancing Trout** (Missoula, MT) : Kristall-Weizen (Crystal Wheat ale) brewed with malted wheat, pale caramel malt, and Cascade hops from Yakima. Moderately hopped with a smooth aftertaste. **16 oz. pint 3.95**

**Hofbrauhaus Dunkel** (Germany): Founded in 1589 this was the official brewery of the Bavarian royal court. The Dunkel is an incredibly approachable dark lager. Light and refreshing.

**Hoegaarden White Bier** (Belgium): Flavored with coriander seed and Curacao orange peel. A very light and refreshing unfiltered white wheat beer

**Bass Ale:** (England): Calm, quick, sweet initial taste. Malty, unobtrusive, yet zesty, aroma has a hint of caramel. **16 oz. pint 3.95**

**Franziskaner Weisse** (Germany) : A light, fruity, spicy aroma that continues to dominate on the palate with a hint of cloves and bananas. Originally brewed in 1363.

**Lefte Brune** (Belgium): Robustly flavored brown ale with a rich aroma of roasted caramel and hints of chocolate and dark fruit. Slightly sweet, balanced by a spicy hop finish. **0.25L 3.95**

**Hales Cream H.S.B.** (Seattle, WA) : Complex, deep amber color that's both smooth and aromatically bitter. Reminiscent of the famous "special biters" of Great Britain. **16 oz. pint 3.95**

**Spaten Premium (Helles) Bock** (Germany): Golden with a well-balanced hop flavor. The full rounded body is a superb balance between hops and a malty sweetness.
